I am sure there are a number of members who will gladly step up to participate in sponsorship opportunities with naming rights, and we do intend to make the opportunities available. However, even with those expected sponsors, we still will fall short and have to resort to higher debt. A more attainable solution could combine sponsorships with some form of assessment that we can spread across the membership. It would be really simple to fund this project in that manner if we all just put up an equal share to make our goals. If we did choose to go this route, the existing (founding members in place at a certain point) would receive some perks. We could look at spreading out an assessment over a period consistent with the needs of the project. And it would really spread the equity across the
