


# IFC ShortCast

Dear Members,

It has been so nice to see the reactions you all have had with our new home.

I wanted to inform all members as stated in prior emails that the Food & Beverage Minimums have been re-instated effective January 1st 2026 .

**What does this mean for you?** If your membership dues are renewed November 1st, you will be automatically billed for any unspent minimums from “your” prior membership year. As in the past, your minimums are equal to your dues and you have 1 full year (your membership Year) to meet your minimums, this is not a monthly requirement.

The next page in this short-cast has a sample statement.

In the bottom left corner you will see;

- ♦ **Minimum Billing Period Nov1/24—Oct 31/25** This represents “your” membership year when your dues automatically renew & reset your minimums
- ♦ **Unspent Minimum 297.95** This is what you have left to spend on food & beverage only before the end of your membership year.

In this example GM Vincent must spend \$297.95 on food & beverage only, by October 31st 2025 **or that amount will be automatically charged** on November 1st 2025 billing cycle.

- ♦ **Please keep in mind that this amount is for Food & Beverage only. Tax, service/ gratuity or merchandise do not count towards your Food & Beverage minimums.**
- ♦ **As a reminder, the monthly billing cycle is done twice a month, on or about the 1st & 15th of each month.**
- ♦ **Charges on the 1st are all charges from the 15th of the prior month to the end of the month plus all membership dues & minimums owed.**
- ♦ **Charges on the 15th are for all charges from the 1st of the current month to the 15th.**
- ♦ **Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions.**

Dear Members,

Having said that, please keep in mind that we are a private, membership-driven club that does have some requirements and house rules we need to recognize and follow. I would like to just reiterate our club dress code for those who may be uncertain of the club expectations.

- ◆ All members and guests shall dress in an appropriate manner at all times while on the club premises.
- ◆ Shoes, pants, shorts, shirts and cover ups shall be required at all times in the club.
